

Students with Disabilities and NYC Charter Schools

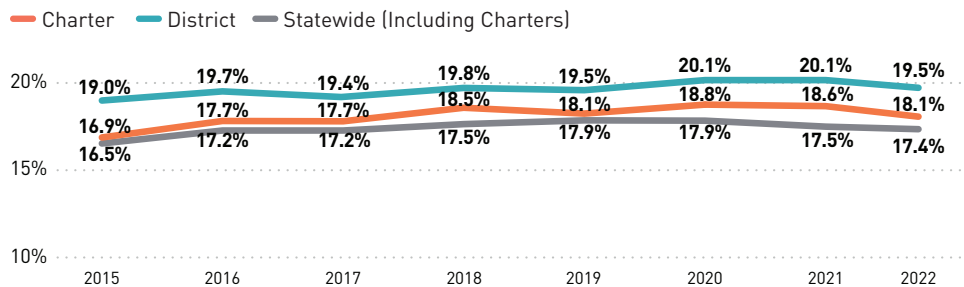

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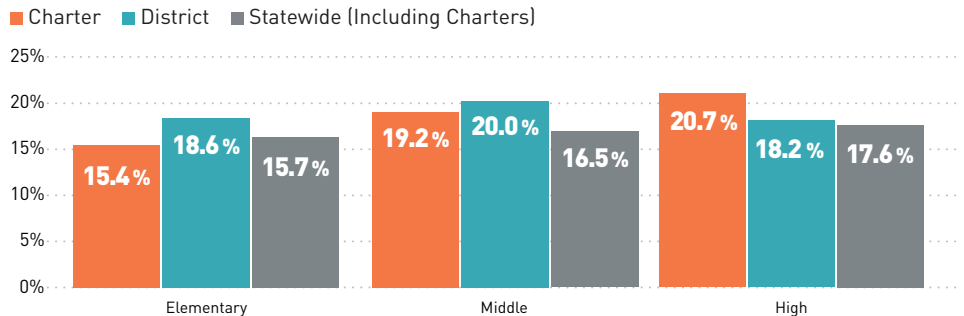
charter schools enroll a higher proportion of students with disabilities than the city wide average

PERCENT OF ENROLLED STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES, 2015-22



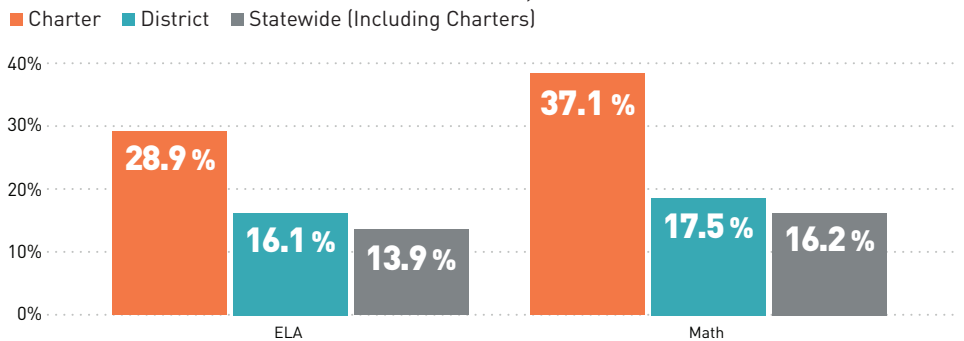
