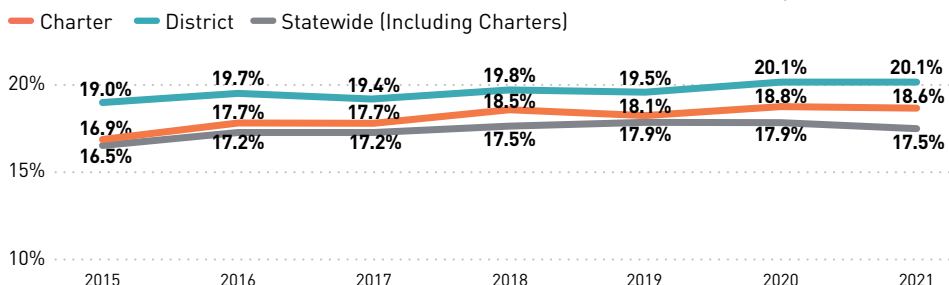

Enrollment of students with IEPs (Individualized Education Plans) in charter schools increased from 16.9% in 2015 to 18.6% in 2021 – an overall

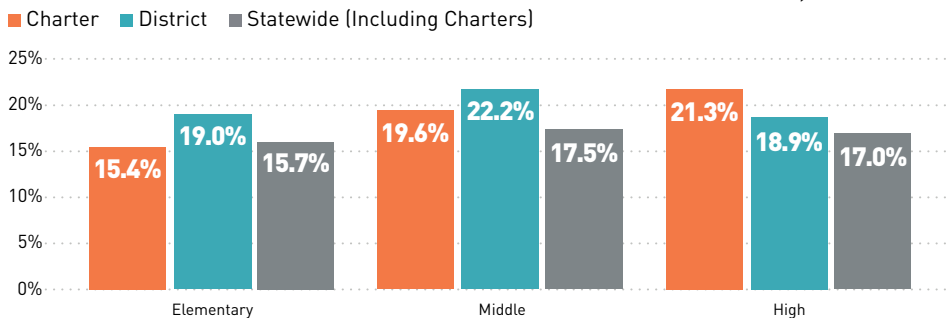

PERCENT OF ENROLLED STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES, 2015-2021



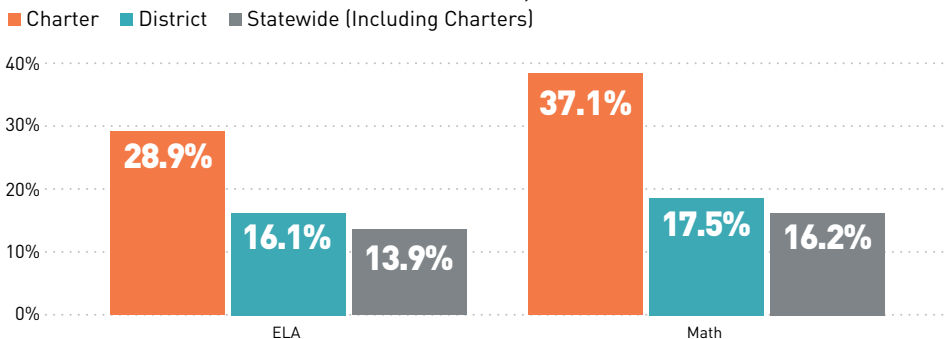
