

Students with Disabilities and NYC Charter Schools

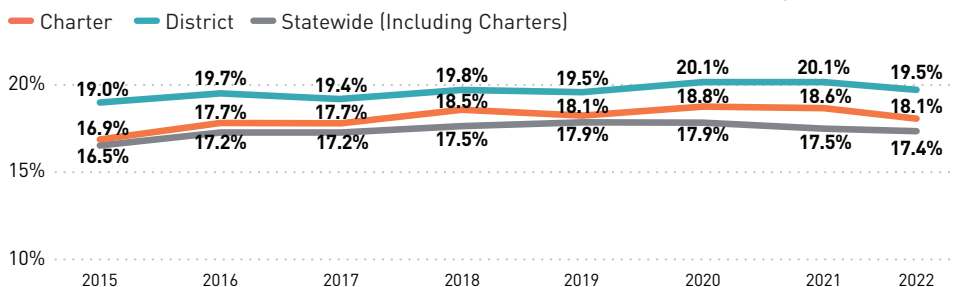

Charter schools are committed to serving all students, including those with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs). For several years now, NYC charter schools have enrolled students with disabilities in numbers comparable to the district.

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charter schools enroll a higher proportion of students with disabilities than the city wide average

PERCENT OF ENROLLED STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES, 2015-22

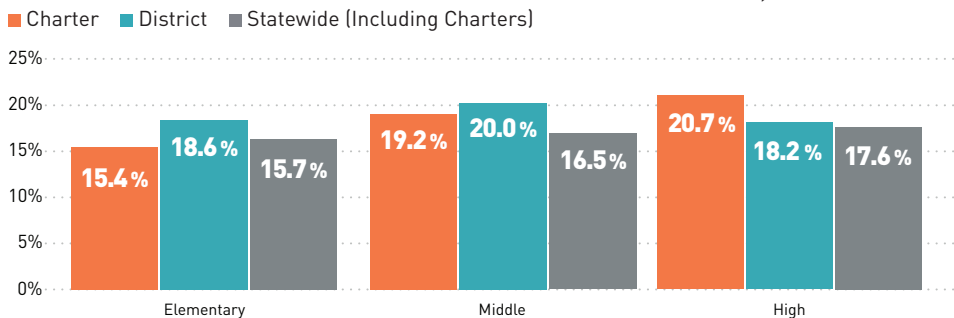

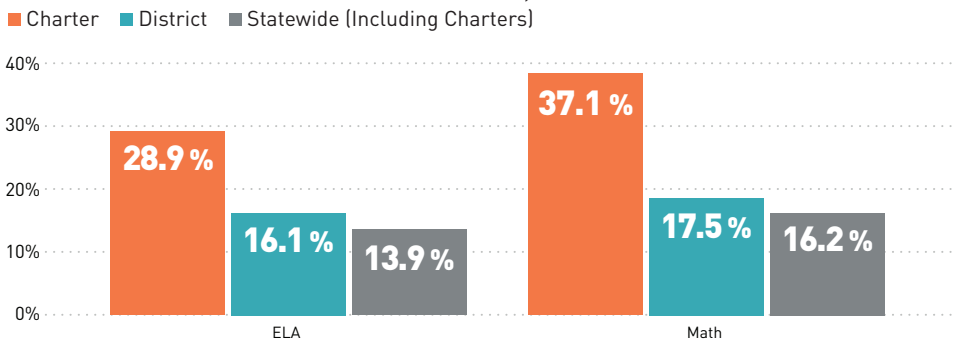
PERCENT OF STUDENTS WITH IEPs BY GRADE BAND, 2021-22
