

The DOE has updated guidance regarding [Extended Use Permits and Implications for Afterschool Programming](#). In light of COVID-19 updates, restrictions on the types of allowable uses have been lifted, although additional permit fees continue to apply and all activities must continue to comply with required reopening guidelines and all applicable [health and safety protocols](#). All permit requests will be reviewed in accordance with the [updated guidance](#) and [Chancellor's Regulation D-180](#); schools should follow the regular process to request a permit using the [Extended Use Application](#).

In the event of a closure due to confirmed COVID-19 cases at the school, extended-use permits will be denied or revoked by the BCO extended-use staff for the duration of such closure. Schools will be notified should a permit be revoked due to a COVID-19-related closure.
