

Previously announced guidance regarding [immunization requirements for the 2020–21 school year](#) outlined state requirements for the completion of mandated immunizations. Students must be in compliance with vaccines, or show proof of scheduled vaccines, as soon as possible, if they have not already done so.

For students who are not in compliance, [warning letters](#) to families should be sent immediately, and at the latest by **October 9**, notifying families that they have 14 days to comply with immunization requirements or provide proof of scheduled vaccines. The [exclusion letters](#) should be sent 13 days after the date that the warning letter is issued—one day before the date of exclusion. For example, a warning letter sent on **October 9** would mean that a student who has not complied with immunization requirements can no longer attend school as of **October 23**. A notice of exclusion should be sent on **October 22**, stating that the student cannot attend as of **October 23**. Students who are excluded cannot attend school, either in-person or remotely.
