

Time Extensions for Expired or Expiring Certificates

Revised April 2018

Please note that only the Office of Teaching Initiatives in the NYS Education Department can officially determine an applicant's eligibility. This requires the submission of an application, an application fee and a full review of all of the applicant's credentials.

The NYS Board of Regents has changed the time extension for teachers with expired or expiring Initial, Transitional or Provisional Pupil Personnel Services certificates

- Effective March 14, 2017, the Board of Regents voted to extend the time validity of an expired Initial, Transitional or Provisional Pupil Personnel Services certificate for three years from the certificate's expiration date.
- Applicants who will meet **one** of the SED's conditions to extend his/her expiring/expired certificates should **NOT** apply and pay the current non-refundable \$50 fee until **SEVEN months prior** the certificate's expiration date.
- Trans B certificate holders will be eligible to apply for a time extension **ONLY IF** they are currently enrolled in the Trans B program and the college program advisor also submits official verification to the SED that the student is still enrolled and indicates the anticipated completion date.
