





NYC Charter School Facts

Charter School Specialized Programs:

- 51 schools have programs for students with autism or have more than 25% of students with IEPs for Special Education.
- 9 schools have dual language programs.
- **33** schools are offering pre-K.
- **9** schools serve high school students at risk of dropping out.
- schools serve single-sex student populations.

Collective Bargaining Agreements:

20 NYC charter schools (7%) have collective bargaining agreements with the United Federation of Teachers.

Facilities:

43% charter schools are located in buildings owned or leased by the NYC DOE.

57% charter schools are in private (non-DOE) space.
