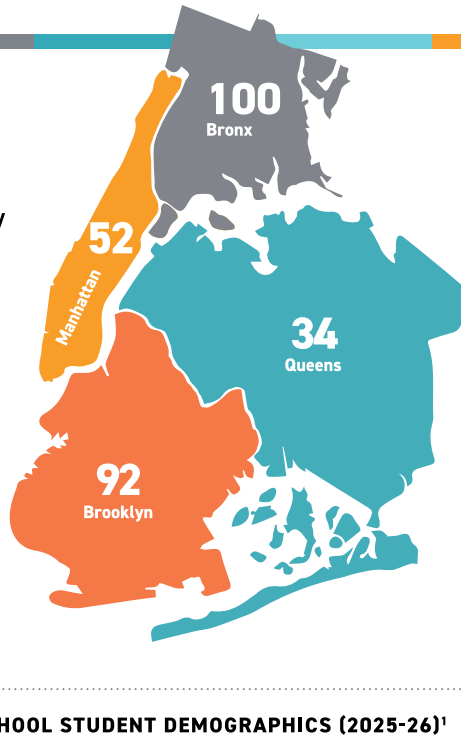

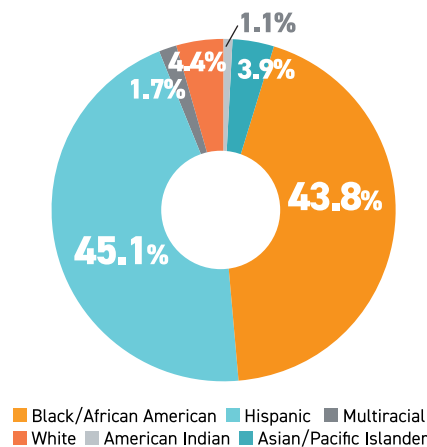

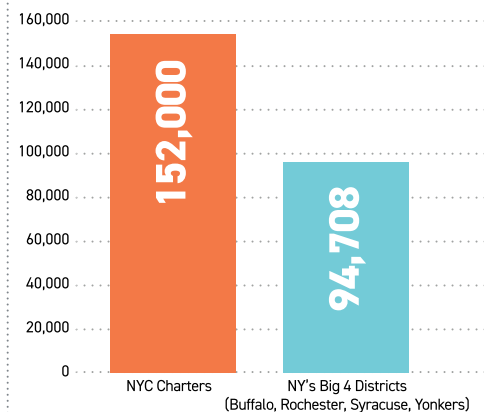

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Charter School Specialized Programs:

- 51** schools have programs for students with autism or have more than 25% of students with IEPs for Special Education
- 9** schools have dual language programs
- 29** schools are offering Pre-K
- 10** schools serve high school students at risk of dropping out
- 8** schools serve single-sex student populations

Collective Bargaining Agreements:

- 20** NYC charter schools (7%) have collective bargaining agreements with the United Federation of Teachers.
