
There are **53** charter schools currently operating in Manhattan, serving over **30,000** students—with **1** in **6** public school students in Manhattan attending a charter school. Manhattan charter schools serve more than twice the percentage of Black students than Manhattan district schools and nearly the same percentages of Hispanic students, English Language Learners, and students with IEPs.





Black public school students in Manhattan attend a charter school.




Black and Hispanic students at Manhattan charter schools achieve higher rates of proficiency by significant margins in both ELA and math.
