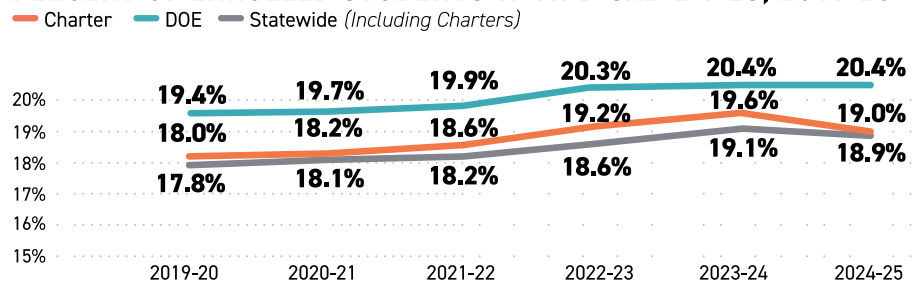

PERCENT OF ENROLLED STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES, 2019-25

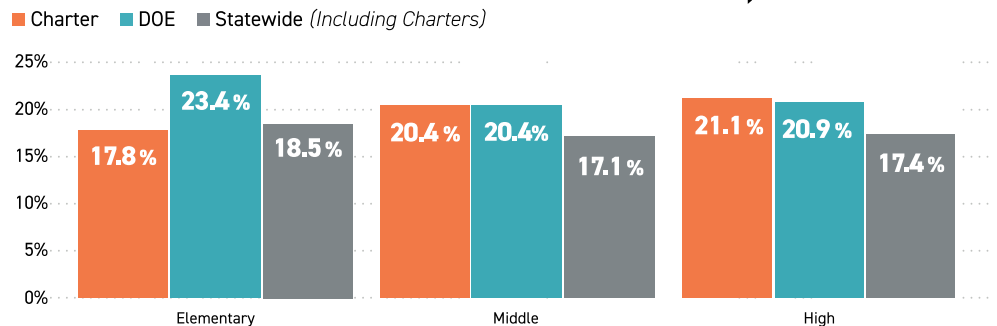

PERCENT OF STUDENTS WITH IEPs BY GRADE BAND, 2024-25



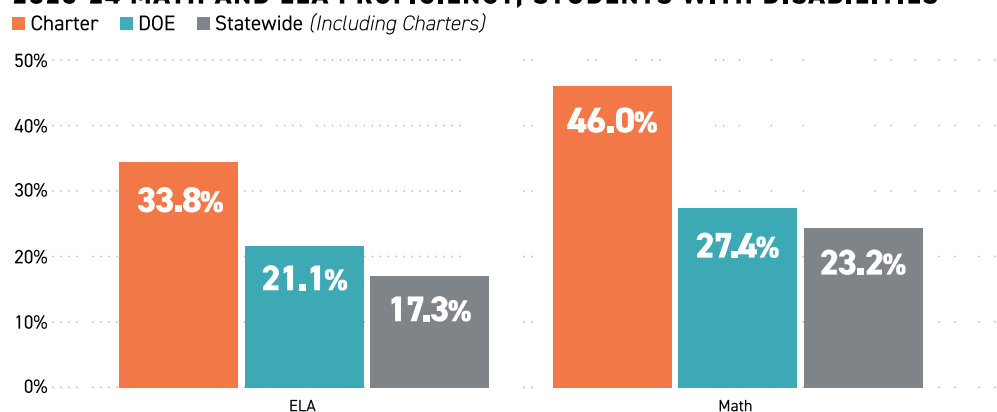
