Schools in DOE	FYI: Charter School Vaccination Policy Reminder for Co-Located
Space	Schools

The message below was refreshed with DOE district principals on November 30.

All charter school staff members, including all contractors of co-located charter schools who work in person in a DOE school setting or DOE building, follow the same vaccination mandate as DOE employees and are required to submit proof of vaccination to their employer (charter school) pursuant to the New York City Commissioner of Health <u>September 15</u> and <u>September 28</u> orders. Based on the orders, charter schools are responsible for monitoring the vaccination status of their staff. Additionally, as is the case for DOE schools, note that:

- School Safety Agents (SSAs) are not responsible for checking vaccination status of charter school staff and contractors entering the building; SSAs were made aware of this policy via phone and email communications leading up to the implementation of the vaccination order. If an SSA has a question about whether someone is a staff member or visitor, they should call the charter school administration directly.
- Visitors to charter schools in DOE space are subject to the Commissioner's mandate for visitors to
  a DOE school building, and the same DOE visitor policy as DOE schools. For more information, see

If there are any questions or clarifications needed regarding health and policy protocols, the co-located schools should discuss these matters in the building council.
